

The concept for the shape of the stand came from the history of the site. It is designed to reflect this through the built-up layers.


Berghaus Buddies Pop-up Pods

Brief:


Design a retail space for Berghaus that sells full price product; this could be a high street store, pop-up or flagship.

Concept:


The concept was to try and get young people outdoors, by creating a program that allowed them to take shelter dogs for walks.




Product Pod 1:25




Privacy Pod 1:25
